For the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (US funds). Payment is in full, non-refundable except as noted below, in accordance with the terms of agreement as provided in this contract. This contract is binding when it has been signed by both buyer and seller and payment has been received in full.

- 1) The breeder/seller guarantees this puppy to be in good health at the time of sale.
- 2) The purchaser agrees to take the puppy for a health check to a licensed veterinarian of purchaser's choice and at the purchaser's expense within 72 hours of receiving the puppy.
- 3) Should the puppy be determined to be in ill health within 72 hours and the cause is clearly attributable to the seller by this veterinarian, the veterinarian must submit a written diagnosis to seller within 24 hours of the determination. The puppy may be returned for refund of purchase price or for another dog of equal value, the choice of which is to be determined by the breeder/seller.

- 4) This health guarantee covers genetic Hip Dysplasia for this puppy for two years (expires \_\_\_\_\_). To qualify for a replacement puppy the following conditions must be met:
  - a) In the event of unsoundness, verification from OFA must be received to determine that it is indeed a genetic problem and not the result of diet or environment. If it is so determined, the puppy will be returned for a refund of purchase price or for another puppy of equal value, the choice of which is to be determined by the breeder/seller. The buyer is responsible for any and all costs incurred by these examinations.
  - b) If you and your veterinarian determine it is in the best interest of the dog to be euthanized, the seller must be contacted beforehand.
  - c) In the event of a death on or before the guarantee expiration, a necropsy report is required from a licensed veterinarian stating the the dog passed as a result of a genetic default, and not caused by the purchaser, deliberate or accidental. In such case the seller will provide the purchaser with a replacement puppy of equal value from current or future litter when available. No monies will be exchanged.
  - d) The puppy must not have been used for breeding until x-rays are completed. Guarantee is void if this is not done.
  - e) Purchaser must pay the difference between initial purchase price and the price of a replacement if applicable. All shipping charges are the responsibility of the buyer.
  - f) If the purchaser chooses to keep an unsound dog, the dog must be spayed or neutered at the purchaser's expense and the registration papers returned to the breeder/seller. No refund or exchange will be made if purchaser chooses to maintain ownership.
  - g) This guarantee is offered to the original purchaser only. If a sale or transfer of this dog becomes apparent, this guarantee is null and void.
- 5) Any veterinarian's diagnosis will be subject to confirmation by a veterinarian chosen by the breeder/seller and at the breeder's/seller's expense. Should such veterinarian not concur with the diagnosis, the matter shall be presented to a third veterinarian mutually agreed upon by the breeder/seller and the purchaser within five (5) days. The expense of the third veterinarian will be split equally between the breeder/seller and the purchaser. The decision of the third veterinarian is binding.
- 6) Replacement puppies are breeder's choice of equal quality as soon as possible.

The described puppy has been purchased from the litter owner under agreement and understanding that the said puppy is eligible for **limited registration only** and will **not** be bred. Offspring will not be eligible for AKC registration. This puppy must be registered with **Wrangell** as the prefix.

This Puppy is being sold with full registration with the additional cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_.

- This puppy must be registered with **Wrangell** as the prefix.
- Buyer agrees to allow puppy to mature before being bred (9 months for males, 18 months or third cycle for females).
- Once a dog has been bred, our health guarantee is no longer valid, so we recommend waiting until the age of two to breed this dog and/or getting the appropriate certifications for hips.
- We believe this dog is of breeding quality at time of sale, but make no guarantee of fertility or future health that may prohibit successful breeding.

**Note to buyer:** The term "breeder" used in this contract refers only to the fact that we are responsible for breeding two dogs for the resulting litter. California state law defines a breeder as "a person, firm, partnership, corporation, or other association that has sold, transferred, or given away all or part of three or more litters or 20 or more dogs during the preceding 12 months that were bred and reared on the premises of the person, firm, partnership, corporation, or other association." We currently choose to only have one or two litters per year.
